



### Supplies needed:

- Gourd Goodness Photopolymer Stamp Set [144785]
- Painted Autumn Designer Series Paper [144613]
- 5/8" (1.6 Cm) Burlap Ribbon [141487]
- Touches Of Nature Elements [144216]
- Tangerine Tango Classic Stampin' Pad [126946]
- Garden Green Classic Stampin' Pad [126973]
- Early Espresso 8-1/2" X 11" Card Stock [119686]
- Very Vanilla 8-1/2" X 11" Card Stock [101650]
- Delicate White Doilies [141701]
- Simply Scored [122334]
- Stampin' Pierce Mat [126199]
- Stampin' Dimensionals [104430]
- Liquid Multipurpose Glue [110755]
- Glue Dots [103683]

### Project Recipe:

1. Cut Early Espresso cardstock 7" x 5" and score at 3 1/2". Burnish with Bone Folder.
2. Cut Painted Autumn DSP 3 3/8" x 4 7/8" and adhere to card base.
3. Cut Early Espresso/Very Vanilla chevron print DSP 3 3/8" x 1".
4. Stamp pumpkin image using Tangerine Tango and Garden Green inks on Very Vanilla cardstock.
5. Stamp "Why, Thank You" using Garden Green on Very Vanilla cardstock and cut out into a thin banner.
6. Fussy cut the pumpkins leaving a thin border using Paper Snips.
7. Cut approximately 7" of 5/8" Burlap Ribbon. Fold to and staple each ribbon to create ruffles.
8. Use Multipurpose Liquid Glue to adhere ribbon to bottom quarter of card. Place adhesive blocks on top of ribbon to set up.

9. Adhere 1" DSP using Foam Adhesive Strips on top of ribbon.
10. Use Multipurpose Glue and adhere Touches of Nature Element on top of chevron DSP.
11. Cut off bottom piece of Delicate White Doily and adhere to bottom of pumpkins.
12. Stack 3 Stampin' Dimensionals on top of each other and place them in two spots on large pumpkin. Adhere to 1" strip.
13. Use Mini Glue Dots to adhere stamped sentiment on to pumpkins.
